



Who Can Enter?


*Winning drawings will be digitally enhanced and enlarged to be applied to a storm drain. Your artwork will be a visual reminder that only rain should go down the storm drain!

Requirements

- Each entry MUST have a copy of the **Official 2018 Schuylkill Street Art Contest Entry Form** filled out legibly and entirely. Tape or glue the form to the back of your drawing – NO staples please. Only ONE entry may be submitted per student.
- Artwork MUST be HORIZONTAL and on an 8½ x11 inch sheet of WHITE paper with no lamination or protruding parts.
- No Trademarks. Please do not use any trademarked phrases, logos, or images (for example "Just Do It" or Coca Cola).

All entries must be mailed by Wednesday, February 28, 2018. (NO entries accepted after this date).

There will be a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner for each of the four counties: Berks, Chester, Montgomery, and Schuylkill County.


Prizes
